State Road (SR) 7/NW 7 Avenue

Project Final Accepted on March 2

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has completed the SR 7/NW 7 Avenue Project. The project limits extend along SR 7/NW 7 Avenue from NW 8 Street to NW 36 Street in Miami-Dade County. The project started on September 21, 2015, and featured approximately \$21.5 million in roadway and safety improvements including the following work:

- Installing a new drainage, water main and sanitary sewer system
- Rebuilding the roadway
- Installing new curb, gutter and sidewalk
- Installing new street lighting and traffic signals
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Installing new signage and pavement markings

FDOT completed this project with the support of elected officials and the community. Central Florida Equipment Rental, Inc. was the contractor.
