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## **FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project**

*State Road (SR) 826/Sunny Isles Boulevard/NE 163 Street from NE 35 Avenue to SR A1A/Collins Avenue*

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**Miami, FL** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 826/Sunny Isles Boulevard/NE 163 Street from NE 35 Avenue to SR A1A/Collins Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in August 2020 and last about seven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$2.1 million.

**The public meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, February 27, 2019, at the Sunny Isles Beach Government Center, First Floor Meeting Room, 18070 Collins Avenue, Sunny Isles Beach, FL 33160.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for this project includes: repaving and restriping the roadway along the project limits; enhancing pedestrian ramps and bicyclist railing; reconstructing damaged concrete driveways and sidewalks; repaving the municipal parking lot at the Intracoastal Waterway; relocating the bus shelter at SR 826 westbound to improve vehicle sight distance; adjusting and constructing storm drains and manholes; renaming the existing “Business Loop” signage to “Gateway Loop”; reconstructing the traffic island at the intersection of SR 826 and N Bay Road, and moving the stop bar and stop sign closer to the intersection; and replacing the traffic signal at the intersection of SR 826 and NE 35 Avenue.
