State Road (SR) 907/Alton Road at Dade Boulevard
Bridge Rehabilitation Project to Start Week of March 4

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a bridge rehabilitation project the week of March 4, 2019. The project limits extend along SR 907/Alton Road at Dade Boulevard over the Collins Canal (bridge number 870665) in the City of Miami Beach.

The project will cost an estimated \$878,038. The work will take approximately six months to be completed. The project includes repairing the underside of the bridge.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
