Lane Closures for Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Replacement

Miami, Fla. – The following closures will be scheduled as noted below to allow the contractor to replace CCTV cameras and support poles:

- Monday, March 25 - The ramp from NW 151 Street to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Turn south at NW 7 Avenue
 - Turn east at NW 135 Street to access the southbound I-95 entrance ramp
- Tuesday, March 26 - One outside lane on southbound I-95 will be closed from approximately NW 106 Street to NW 102 Street, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Wednesday, March 27 - One lane on southbound State Road (SR) 7/US 441 will be closed south of the intersection of SR 7/US 441 with NW 7 Avenue Extension, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Thursday, March 28 and Friday, March 29 - One lane on eastbound SR 90/SW 8 Street will be closed at SW 4 Avenue between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the Districtwide Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS).
