Intersection Enhancement Project Begins Week of April 29

State Road (SR) 907/Alton Road at Michigan Avenue

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an intersection enhancement project the week of April 29, 2019. The project is at the intersection of SR 907/Alton Road at Michigan Avenue in the City of Miami Beach.

The project will cost an estimated \$1.7 million. The work will take approximately seven months to be completed. The project includes widening the roadway to accommodate a second southbound left-turn lane at the intersection of Alton Road and Michigan Avenue; installing drainage inlets at various locations; removing and relocating landscaping as needed; repaving and restriping the roadway; upgrading pedestrian curb ramps; installing new traffic and pedestrian signals and signs; and installing new street lighting.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to periodically close lanes. Construction will be done in stages to minimize impacts to the public during special events and peak periods of traffic. The department will make sure traffic continues to flow safely through the work zones.
