Roadway Project Begins the Week of May 13 *State Road (SR) 25/US 27/W Okeechobee Road*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin a roadway safety improvement project the week of May 13, 2019. The project limits extend along SR 25/US 27/W Okeechobee Road at W 16 Avenue/NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road in the City of Hialeah. This project will cost an estimated \$564,204 and will take about five months to complete.

The proposed work includes extending the southbound left-turn lane along W Okeechobee Road onto eastbound W 29 Street, adding a concrete traffic separator along W 16 Avenue, installing high-emphasis crosswalks, updating traffic signals and pavement markings, updating pedestrian signals and curb ramps and repaving and restriping the roadway.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to temporarily close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
