State Road (SR) A1A/MacArthur Causeway
Eastbound Left Lane Continuous Closure Starts Night of May 15
Eastbound center lane to reopen

Miami, Fla. – On Wednesday night, May 15, the contractor will establish a new work zone along the eastbound left lane on the SR A1A/MacArthur Causeway East Bridge (bridge number 870077). Two eastbound lanes will be closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. to close the eastbound left lane between Terminal Island and Alton Road. The Alton Road flyover will also be closed Wednesday night while the contractor moves barrier wall and restripes the roadway. The flyover will reopen by 6 a.m.

By 6 a.m. Thursday, May 16, the right lane will remain open, the center lane will reopen and the left lane will remain continuously closed for approximately two months while workers replace the bridge deck in this area. A second eastbound lane closure will occur as needed between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Westbound lanes will continue to be closed as needed during these hours as well. **Two lanes in each direction and the Alton Road flyover will be open at all times during daytime hours.**

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.

The closures are part of the SR A1A/MacArthur Causeway Bridge Rehabilitation Project.
