Closure of Eastbound I-95 for Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) Replacement

Miami, Fla. – All eastbound I-95 travel lanes will be closed east of I-95 on Wednesday, July 10 and Thursday, July 11, between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Drivers can:

NORTHBOUND I-95 DRIVERS SHOULD:

- Exit at NW 62 Street, then turn right onto NW 62 Street
- At NE 2 Avenue, stay to the right to head east on NW 61 Street
- Turn right onto southbound US 1/Biscayne Boulevard
- Turn left on NE 36 Street to access the I-95 east ramp

SOUTHBOUND I-95 DRIVERS SHOULD:

- Continue south on I-95, then exit at the ramp to I-395 east (Exit 2D)
- Exit at US 1/Biscayne Boulevard, then make a left onto US 1/Biscayne Boulevard
- Turn right on NW 36 St to access the I-95 eastbound ramp

EASTBOUND SR 112 DRIVERS SHOULD:

- Exit at NW 12 Avenue, then turn right onto southbound NW 12 Avenue
- Turn left on NW 36 Street to access the I-95 east ramp after NE 2 Avenue

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the Districtwide Design/Build Project to replace Intelligent Transportation Systems Devices (ITS).
