Weekend Closure of Southbound I-95 Exit Ramp onto NW 125 Street Begins Friday, July 19
State Road (SR) 922/NW 125 Street Roadway Safety Improvement Project

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin an around-the-clock continuous closure of the southbound I-95 exit ramp onto NW 125 Street from Friday, July 19 at 10 p.m. until Monday, July 22 at 5 a.m.

Commuters along southbound I-95 wishing to exit at NW 125 Street will be detoured to NW 135 St/Opa-locka Blvd or NW 103 Street. Eastbound and westbound motorists along NW 125 St will remain unaffected. Access to properties will always be maintained.

This closure is part of the ongoing roadway safety improvement project along NW 125 Street. This closure will allow crews to continue working on the widening of this southbound I-95 exit ramp onto NW 125 St.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
