Toll Collection Starts September 23 on State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Express Lanes

Miami, Fla. – On Monday, September 23, toll collection will start in the Palmetto Express Lanes, on both the northbound and southbound directions, between West Flagler Street and NW 154 Street, and along I-75 from Palmetto Expressway to NW 170 Street.

Please refer to the overhead toll rate signs for the toll amount. Tolls will be collected electronically. Drivers using the express lanes will need to have an active SunPass, or other interoperable transponder – no exceptions, no TOLL-BY-PLATE.

Express lane entrance and exit locations are posted on overhead signs. **Do not drive over the ELMs to get in or out of the express lanes.** Access points to and from the express lanes are limited. Drivers should plan their trip ahead of time and know where to get in and out of the express lanes to reach their destinations. Attached please find detailed information about the Palmetto Express access points.

The express lanes are monitored for incidents 24 hours a day, seven days a week. If your vehicle breaks down, call the Florida Highway Patrol Communication Center at *347 for help. Remember to keep calm and stay inside your vehicle until help arrives.
