**New Seven Mile Bridge Temporary Closures on Thursday, September 19**  
*Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Monroe County, Fla.** – The Seven Mile Bridge, located over Moser Channel between MM 40 and MM 46.8 in Monroe County, will be closed intermittently between 11:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 19 and 2 a.m. on Friday, September 20, to complete repairs safely as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

Closures are expected to last approximately 30 minutes. During that time, drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge approach until notified by the police officers that traffic may resume.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
