Roadway Construction Project Begins the Week of November 18

State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of November 18, 2019. The project limits extend along various SR 826/Palmetto Expressway ramps at SR 924/Gratigny Parkway in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$428,628 and will take about four months to complete.

The ramps include:

- Westbound Gratigny Parkway to southbound Palmetto Expressway
- Northbound Palmetto Expressway to eastbound Gratigny Parkway
- Southbound Palmetto Expressway to NW 138 Street

The proposed work includes repaving and restriping the roadway along various SR 826/Palmetto Expressway ramps, installing guardrail and replacing signage.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages. Lane closures and detours will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
