I-95, 95 Express Lanes, State Road (SR) 112 and I-195 Lane Closures

Miami, Fla. – The following closures on I-95, 95 Express Lanes, SR 112 and I-195 will be scheduled as noted below:

SPECIAL NOTES:

- Drivers should expect delays when traveling along the closure limits. Drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes during closures.
- Please note that there will be no construction activities while the newly poured concrete pavement cures.
- Construction related closures will be suspended from Wednesday, November 27 through Sunday, December 1 in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday.
- **Continuous closures are noted in red.**

Weekend Closures

Friday, December 6 through Monday, December 9:

- Two southbound, I-95 general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 79 Street to NW 46 Street on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- The southbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- **The northbound 95 Express Lanes will be continuously closed from SR 112 to the Golden Glades Interchange starting at 11 p.m. on Friday, December 6 until 5:30 a.m. on Monday, December 9.**
- Up to two northbound, I-95 general purpose lanes will be closed from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street on Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- There will be a full closure of NW 35 Street and NW 36 Street from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue on Friday between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m., to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on the ramps over the roadways. Drivers should follow the posted detour signs.

- There will be a full closure of NW 46 Street on Saturday, from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue, between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m., to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on I-95 over the roadway.
 - Eastbound drivers on NW 46 Street can:
 - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue, then turn right on NW 54 Street.
 - Turn right on NW 5 Avenue to connect with NW 46 Street.
 - Westbound drivers on NW 46 Street can:
 - Turn right on NW 5 Avenue, then turn left on NW 54 Street.
 - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 46 Street.

Weeknight Closures

- Monday, December 2 - The eastbound SR 112 and westbound I-195 ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue north on I-95 and exit at NW 62 Street.
 - Turn left at NW 62 Street to access the southbound I-95 ramp.
- Monday, December 2 through Thursday, December 5 - There will be a full closure of NW 35 Street and NW 36 Street from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue on Friday between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m., to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on the ramps over the roadways. Drivers should follow the posted detour signs.
- Monday, December 2 through Thursday, December 5 - There will be a full closure of NW 46 Street, from NW 7 Avenue to NW 5 Avenue, between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 6 a.m., to allow the project contractor to replace the traffic railing on I-95 over the roadway.
 - Eastbound drivers on NW 46 Street can:
 - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue, then turn right on NW 54 Street.
 - Turn right on NW 5 Avenue to connect with NW 46 Street.
 - Westbound drivers on NW 46 Street can:
 - Turn right on NW 5 Avenue, then turn left on NW 54 Street.
 - Turn left on NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 46 Street.
- Monday, December 2 through Thursday, December 5 - Up to three northbound, I-95 general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 53 Street to NW 79 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. The third lane will be closed at 10:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, December 3 through Thursday, December 5 - The NW 62 Street entrance ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go north on NW 7 Avenue.
 - Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the northbound I-95 entrance ramp.
- Tuesday, December 3 through Thursday, December 5 - The NW 69 Street entrance ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Turn right on NW 5 Court, then make a left at NW 71 Street.
 - Turn right on NW 7 Avenue.
 - Turn right on NW 79 Street to access the northbound I-95 entrance ramp.

- Tuesday, December 3 through Thursday, December 5 - The northbound I-95 exit ramp to NW 79 Street/NW 81 Street will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit at NW 95 Street, then make a left at NW 95 Street.
 - Turn left at NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 79 Street.
- Tuesday, December 3 through Thursday, December 5 - The southbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from the Golden Glades Interchange to SR 112 between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Monday, December 2 - Up two four southbound, I-95 general-purpose lanes will be closed from NW 46 Street to NW 32 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The third and fourth lanes will be closed at 11 p.m. ***Only one southbound, general-purpose lane will be open during the closure period.***
- Tuesday December 3 through Thursday, December 5 - One lane on the northbound 95 Express Lanes will be closed from NW 85 Street to NW 135 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of I-95 Design/Build Projects to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95, from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street, and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street, as well as the Intelligent Transportation System devices.
