NW 24 Avenue Closed for Railroad Crossing Work
Friday, December 13 – Wednesday, December 18, 2019

Miami, Fla. – Beginning at 10 p.m. on Friday, December 13, 2019, until 4 a.m., Wednesday, December 18, 2019, the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close NW 24 Avenue at the railroad crossing located between NW 21 Terrace and NW 23 Street in the City of Miami, Miami-Dade County, weather permitting.

This closure will allow workers to replace the existing tracks and crossing surface to improve ride quality along to the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC). During this closure, northbound and southbound traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Traffic traveling northbound on NW 24 Avenue will make a right at NW 21 Terrace, a left at NW 23 Avenue, another left at NW 23 Street and will continue until NW 24 Avenue.
- Traffic traveling southbound on NW 24 Avenue will make a right at NW 23 Street, a left at NW 24 Court, another left at NW 21 Terrace and will continue until NW 24 Avenue.
