Construction Completed on SR A1A/Indian Creek Drive Roadway Project

Nearly \$1.1 million in improvements were made between 63 Street and Abbott Avenue

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) recently completed a roadway improvement project along SR A1A/Indian Creek Drive between 63 Street and Abbott Avenue. The project, which began in May 2019 and ended on November 30, featured approximately \$1.1 million in roadway and safety improvements.

The following work was performed on the project: repaving and restriping the roadway; upgrading pedestrian signalization; adjusting manholes and valves; rebuilding existing pedestrian ramps; replacing utility boxes within limits of sidewalk construction; installing a shared bicycle lane “sharrows”; and enhancing signage and pavement markings.

FDOT completed this project with the support of elected officials and the community in the City of Miami Beach. Roadway Construction, LLC. was the contractor.
