Roadway Construction Project Begins the Week of January 6 *State Road (SR) 25/NE 36 Street at NE 1 Avenue*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of January 6, 2020. The project limits extend along the intersection of SR 25/NE 36 Street and NE 1 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$569,569.

The work will last about six months and include the following: removing the existing pedestrian flashers and installing new traffic signals at the intersection; installing new pedestrian traffic signals and upgrading the signage; installing additional light poles at the intersection; repaving and restriping of the intersection and providing high emphasis crosswalks.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
