FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for two Repaving and Safety Improvement Projects

State Road (SR) 932/NW 103 Street/49 Street from West 3 Avenue to East 10 Avenue

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Hearing for two repaving and safety improvement projects along SR 932/NW 103 Street/49 Street from West 3 Avenue to East 10 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in June 2022 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost for these projects is about \$3 million.

A Public Hearing will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 29, 2020 at the John F. Kennedy Library, 190 West 49 Street, Hialeah, FL 33012. A formal presentation will start at 6 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss these projects.

The proposed improvements include: closing the median opening on SR 932/49 Street at East 8 Court to restrict left turns through the intersection; installing right-turn-only signs and pavement markings on East 8 Court approaching SR 932/49 Street; extending the left-turn lane from eastbound SR 932/49 Street to northbound SR 953/East 8 Avenue; reconstructing driveways at various locations; replacing damaged storm drain inlets; repaving and restriping the roadway; updating traffic signs and signals, and improving pedestrian crosswalks, signs and signals.
