Snake Creek Canal Bridge (Bridge Number 900077) Full Road Closure

Wednesday, February 12

Islamorada, Village of Islands, Fla. – On Wednesday, February 12, the Snake Creek Canal Bridge at Mile Marker (MM) 85 in Monroe County will be closed to all traffic between 1 a.m. and 3 a.m. while workers replace a motor.

During this closure, drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.

Please note there will NOT be a closure on Wednesday, February 5, 2020.
