FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 969/Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue from West Flagler Street to NW 7 Street

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 969/Milam Dairy Road/NW 72 Avenue from West Flagler Street to NW 7 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in July 2021 and last about seven months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$1.3 million.

A Public Meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, February 25, 2020, at the Robert King High Park (Meeting Room), 7025 West Flagler Street, Miami, FL 33144. FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed work for this project includes: repaving and restriping the roadway; reconstructing driveways and sidewalks with damaged concrete; upgrading pedestrian signs and signals; adjusting storm drain and utility manholes; upgrading pavement markings and crosswalks at signalized intersections; enhancing signal timing and updating lighting within the project limits.
