**FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for two Roadway Improvement Projects
and one Bridge Improvement Project**

*State Road (SR) 924/Gratigny Road/NW 119 Street
from SR 9/NW 27 Avenue to SR 7/NW 7 Avenue*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Meeting for two roadway improvement projects and one bridge improvement project along SR 924/Gratigny Road/NW 119 Street from SR 9/NW 27 Avenue to SR 7/NW 7 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County. The scope of work for these projects is listed in the enclosed Public Meeting notification. Construction is expected to begin in March 2022 and last about one year. The estimated construction cost for these projects is \$4 million.

A Public Meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 27, 2020 at the North Central Branch Library, 9590 NW 27 Avenue, Miami, FL 33147. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The proposed improvements include: replacing existing bridge features; repairing the deck on the bridge; upgrading bridge guardrail; repaving and restriping the roadway; removing abandoned driveways along NW 119 Street; reconstructing sidewalk, curb and gutter; adjusting the existing storm drain features; upgrading street signs and signals; providing high emphasis crosswalk markings at all signals; upgrading pedestrian ramps, detectors and signs; installing a new crosswalk at NW 10 Avenue with countdown signal heads; converting the eastbound and westbound left turn lane to an exclusive left turn at NW 17 Avenue and enhancing the eastbound and westbound left turn lanes to provide better driver visibility at SR 9/NW 27 Avenue.
