**Daytime Single Lane Shifts on the New Seven Mile Bridge
Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway
*Tuesday, March 10 and Thursday, March 12***

Monroe County, Fla. – On Tuesday, March 10 and Thursday, March 12, there will be a single lane shift on the Seven Mile Bridge, located over Moser Channel between MM 40 and MM 46.8 in Monroe County, while the contractor performs concrete pours and striping work. This work is part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project, and will be completed between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on both days.

To perform this work safely, southbound and northbound traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
