Intermittent Bridge Closures to Occur on US 1 at Snake Creek Canal (Bridge Number 900077)

Monday, April 6

Islamorada, Village of Islands, Fla. – Beginning Monday, April 6 through Friday, April 10, temporary nighttime 15-minute closures may occur on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge (MM 85) between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. The roadway may be closed in both directions while new structural components are installed.

This work requires the drawbridge to be opened and closed one or more times. Drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
