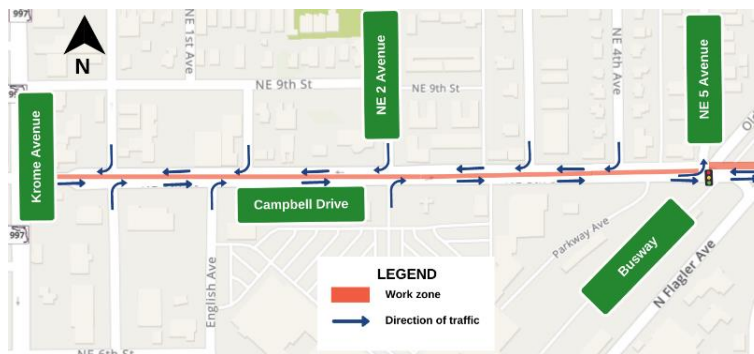

SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive Traffic Shift Rescheduled for October 14

From just west of the US 1 Busway to east of Krome Avenue

Miami, Fla. – The contractor has rescheduled a traffic shift along SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to Wednesday morning, October 14. One eastbound lane and one westbound lane will be placed on the outermost travel lanes from just west of the busway to east of Krome Avenue. Left turn movements will be temporarily restricted at NE 2 Avenue and Krome Avenue during this work to allow the contractor to rebuild the concrete island in the center of the roadway. This work is expected to last several weeks.



The intersection of Campbell Drive and Flagler Avenue will also remain closed for roadway work.
