Weekend Closures of NW South River Drive between NW 122 Street and NW 121 Way *September 13 – 22, 2024*

MIAMI, Fla. – All lanes along NW South River Drive between NW 122 Street and NW 121 Way will be closed for two consecutive weekends, starting at 9 p.m. Friday, September 13 until Sunday, September 22. Limited access in and out of NW 121 Way will be provided with the assistance of flaggers. This closure will allow the contractor to install drainage structures in the area. The weekend dates are below:

- Friday, September 13 until Sunday, September 15
- Friday, September 20 until Sunday, September 22

The following traffic patterns will be in place:

- Full closure along NW South River Drive between NW 121 Way and NW 122 Street
- A single lane will be maintained along NW 121 Way. Flaggers will be on site managing the travel flow in both directions
- Motorists heading north along NW 121 Way, will only be able to make a right on to NW South River Drive toward NW 116 Way to access SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road
- Motorists heading east on NW South River Drive wishing to access NW 121 Way, will be provided access by the flagger
- Motorists traveling along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road wishing to access NW South River Drive, west of NW 121 way, will be detoured to the NW 107 Avenue intersection, to make a left on NW 127 Street, and a right to access NW South River Drive
- Motorists traveling along SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road wishing to access NW South River Drive, east of NW 121 way, will be detoured to the NW 116 Way intersection, and to make a right to access NW South River Drive
- Access along NW 122 Street will be provided at all times

Detours will be clearly marked and access to businesses and neighborhoods will be maintained at all times. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

This project is part of the corridor wide reconstruction of the SR 25/US 27/Okeechobee Road from the Broward County Line to SR 826/Palmetto Expressway. This work will improve safety, enhance mobility along this Strategic Intermodal Systems (SIS) corridor, and inspire innovative transportation solutions, connecting commuters throughout Miami-Dade County.
