## Continuous Lane Closure along NW 95 Street between Frontage Road and NW 80 Avenue

March 20, 2026

**MIAMI, Fla.** – Starting on Friday, March 20, 2026, at 9 p.m., travel lanes in both directions along NW 95 Street between Frontage Road and NW 80 Avenue will be closed to traffic continuously for two weeks. Travel lanes are expected to open to traffic on Monday, March 30, 2026 at 5:30 a.m. This closure is necessary for the reconstruction of NW 95 Street. Please use caution and follow the posted signage.

The following traffic patterns and detours will be in place:

- Intersection of S.R. 25/U.S. 27/Okeechobee Road, NW 95 Street, and Frontage Road will remain open.
- Motorists traveling along eastbound/southbound Frontage Road, wishing to access NW 95 Street, will be detoured to continue along eastbound/southbound Frontage Road.
- Motorists traveling along westbound/northbound NW 95 Street, wishing to access Frontage Road, will be detoured as follows:
  - Turn right at NW 80 Avenue.
  - Turn right at NW 98 Street.
  - Turn right at NW 77 Avenue to access Frontage Road.
- Motorists traveling along eastbound/southbound NW 95 Street, wishing to access Frontage Road, will be detoured to make right at NW 77 Avenue.

This project is part of the corridor wide reconstruction of the Okeechobee Road from the Broward County Line to Palmetto Expressway. This work will improve safety, enhance mobility along this Strategic Intermodal Systems (SIS) corridor, and inspire innovative transportation solutions, connecting commuters throughout Miami-Dade County.
