### Detours Along State Road (SR) 7/US 441/NW 2 Ave and NW 7 Ave Ext Begin Tonight

**Miami, Fla.** – Beginning Wednesday, April 29 at 11:59 p.m. until 7 a.m. the following morning, southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed and traffic will be detoured at NW 177 Street. The left turn lanes from eastbound NW 7 Avenue Extension to northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue will also be closed and traffic will be detoured at NW 7 Avenue.

These closures will allow crews to perform roadway widening work at the intersection of SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Ave and NW 7 Avenue Extension in the City of Miami Gardens. The following detours will be in place overnight.

- Motorists traveling along southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue who wish to access the Golden Glades Interchange can:
  - Turn right onto westbound NW 177 Street.
  - Turn left onto southbound NW 7 Avenue.
  - Turn left onto NW 7 Avenue Extension.
  - Turn right onto southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue in order to access the Golden Glades Interchange.
- Motorists traveling along eastbound NW 7 Avenue Extension who wish to turn left onto northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue can:
  - Turn left onto northbound NW 7 Avenue.
  - Turn right onto eastbound NW 177 Street.
  - Turn left onto northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue.
