### **FDOT Announces Completion of SR 953/LeJeune Road Roadway Project**

*From NW 79 Street/E 25 Street to NW 103 Street/E 49 Street*

**MIAMI, Fla.** – On Friday, September 20, 2024, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), completed the project along State Road (SR) 953/LeJeune Road from NW 79 Street/E 25 Street to NW 103 Street/E 49 Street, in the City of Hialeah.

Completed in under a year, the project included installing two new mast arms at the intersection of E 42 Street and E 41 Street; concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, and gutters were reconstructed, and a mid-block crosswalk near Flamingo Elementary was upgraded. Pedestrian and vehicular signage, along with traffic signals, were upgraded using Light-emitting Diode (LED) technology; enhancements were made to drainage systems, abandoned driveways were removed, and the roadway was repaved and restriped.
