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FDOT Completes Roadway Improvements along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/S Dixie Hwy

From east of SW 27 Avenue to I-95

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has completed the roadway project along SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway from east of SW 27 Avenue to I-95. The eleven month project began in October 2019 and cost an estimated \$2.7 million. H&R Paving, Inc. was the contractor awarded the project. FDOT completed this work with the support of elected officials and the community.

The following scope of work was performed on this project: modifying the intersection of SR 5/US 1 and SW 24 Avenue/Calusa Street to restrict left-turn movements from the side streets; upgrading the M-Path crosswalks underneath the Metrorail at the intersections of SR 5/US 1 and SW 22 Avenue, SW 19 Avenue, SW 17 Avenue and SW 16 Avenue; replacing damaged drainage inlet tops; replacing the mast arms at the intersection SR 5/US 1 and SW 22 Avenue; repaving and restriping the roadway throughout the project corridor; upgrading sidewalks, pedestrian curb ramps, signing and pavement markings; and improving signalization and lighting
