FDOT Golden Glades Interchange (GGI) Project Lane and Ramp Closures & Detours

Sunday, October 13 to Friday, October 18

MIAMI, Fla. – As part of the ongoing interchange reconstruction work, contractors for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be implementing various roadway closures and detours. These closures will allow crews to perform bridge work, stormwater drainage installation, roadway paving, utility work and temporary concrete barrier wall installation.

Sunday, October 13 to Friday, October 18 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

The ramp from the Golden Glades Interchange to southbound State Road (SR) 9 will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Take the ramp to southbound SR 9A/Interstate 95 (I-95)
- Exit at SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard and turn right onto westbound SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard
- Turn right onto northbound NW 22 Avenue or continue west and turn right onto northbound NW 27 Avenue to access SR 9

The ramp from the Golden Glades Interchange to southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Take the ramp to southbound SR 9A/I-95
- Exit at SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard and turn right onto westbound SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard
- Turn left onto southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue

NW 6 Court between SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard and SR 916/NW 135 Street will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Turn right onto westbound SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard
- Turn left onto southbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound SR 916/NW 135 Street to access NW 6 Court

Sunday, October 13 to Thursday, October 17 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

The ramp from southbound SR 91/Florida's Turnpike to westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Continue south and take the ramp to SR 9A/I-95 and SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue

- Exit at SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue and turn right onto northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Take the ramp to SR 91/Florida's Turnpike and westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Continue north and take the ramp to westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

The ramp from NW 167 Street to westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Take the ramp to northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 2 Avenue
- Turn left onto westbound NW 7 Avenue Extension
- Continue west for westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway

Wednesday, October 16 to Friday, October 18 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

Northbound NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Turn left onto westbound NW 165 Street
- Turn right onto northbound NW 16 Court
- For eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway or eastbound NW 167 Street, turn right onto the entrance ramp
- For westbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway, turn left onto westbound NW 167 Street, turn right onto northbound NW 17 Avenue and turn left onto the entrance ramp
- For northbound NW 12 Avenue, turn left onto westbound NW 167 Street, turn right onto northbound NW 17 Avenue and turn right onto eastbound NW 175 Street

Southbound NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue at SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Turn right onto westbound NW 167 Street
- Turn left onto southbound NW 17 Avenue
- For eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway, turn left onto the entrance ramp
- For southbound NW 13 Avenue, turn left onto eastbound NW 167 Street

Wednesday, October 16 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

The ramp from northbound SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Go south on SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard
- Take the ramp onto northbound SR 9A/I-95

The ramp from northbound SR 9 to the Golden Glades Interchange will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Go east on SR 916/Opa-locka Boulevard
- Take the ramp onto northbound SR 9A/I-95

Thursday, October 17 between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

Eastbound NW 167 Street between NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue and NW 10 Avenue will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Go south on NW 12 Avenue/NW 13 Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound NW 165 Street
- Turn left onto northbound NW 163 Drive to access NW 10 Avenue

Friday, October 18 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.:

The ramp from NW 2 Avenue to northbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed and traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Turn right onto eastbound NW 168 Street
- Turn right onto southbound North Miami Avenue
- Turn left onto eastbound NW 167 Street
- Turn left onto northbound SR 915/NE 6 Avenue
- Turn right onto eastbound SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive
- Take the ramp to northbound SR 9A/I-95

Continuous closure:

NW 6 Avenue is closed between NW 151 Street and NW 162 Street while construction crews work on stormwater drainage improvements and replace the bridge over the Biscayne Canal. Contractors for Florida Power & Light (FPL) and City of North Miami Beach are also performing utility work along NW 6 Avenue. A detour is in place until summer 2025 to complete this phase of work.

Drivers and pedestrians who want to go north onto NW 6 Avenue from the intersection of NW 151 Street and NW 6 Avenue will be detoured as follows:

- Go east along NW 151 Street
- Turn right onto southbound South Biscayne River Drive
- Take the third exit at the roundabout onto northbound North Miami Avenue
- Turn left onto northbound Memorial Highway, which converts to NW 2 Avenue
- Continue north along NW 2 Avenue to NW 165 Street

Drivers and pedestrians who want to go south onto NW 6 Avenue from the intersection of NW 165 Street and NW 2 Avenue will be detoured as follows:

- Continue south along NW 2 Avenue, which converts to Memorial Highway
- Turn right onto southbound North Miami Avenue
- Turn right onto northbound South Biscayne River Drive
- Turn left onto westbound NW 151 Street
- Continue west along NW 151 Street to NW 6 Avenue

These closures below will occur nightly as needed:

SR 9A/I-95 between SR 916/NW 135 Street and the Golden Glades Interchange

- At 9 p.m., one lane in both directions will be closed as needed.
- At 11 p.m., a second lane in both directions will be closed as needed.

SR 826/Palmetto Expressway between NW 12 Avenue and NW 7 Avenue Extension

- At 9 p.m., one lane in both directions will be closed as needed.
- At 11 p.m., a second lane in both directions will be closed as needed.

SR 91/Florida's Turnpike between SR 860/NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive and SR 9A/I-95

- From 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., up to two lanes in both directions will be closed as needed.

Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
