SR 90/Tamiami Trail/SW 8 Street Roadway Project Begins Week of November 4

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of November 4, 2024. The project limits extend along State Road (SR) 90/Tamiami Trail/SW 8 Street from SW 27 Avenue to SW 2 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. The current construction cost is \$5.9 million and will take about 11 months to complete.

The scope of work includes improving stormwater drainage systems between SW 21 Avenue and SW 19 Avenue, replacing traffic signals at the intersections of SW 4 Avenue, SW 3 Avenue and SW 2 Avenue, adding a new travel lane along SW 8 Street between SW 4 Avenue and SW 2 Avenue, reconstructing concrete sidewalks, upgrading pedestrian signalization and signage and repaving and restriping the roadway.

Access to and from adjacent neighborhoods and businesses will be maintained during construction. Please note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
