### **SR 90/US 41/SW 8 Street Roadway Project Begins Week of August 5**

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of August 5, 2024. The project limits extend along State Road (SR) 90/US 41/SW 8 Street from SW 65 Avenue to SW 29 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$2.8 million and will take about 10 months to complete.

The scope of work includes adding six signalized mid-block pedestrian crossings at various locations, upgrading pedestrian ramps, sidewalks, and detectable warning surfaces, and installing signage, pavement markings, pedestrian detectors, and pushbuttons. Additionally, the project involves installing high-emphasis crosswalks, reconstructing concrete sidewalks, upgrading existing light poles with light-emitting diodes (LEDs) at various locations, and repaving and restriping the roadway.

Access to and from adjacent neighborhoods and businesses will be maintained during construction. Please note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
