FDOT to Host SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway at North College Road Design Project Public Meeting *September 24, 2024*

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an in-person and online Public Meeting for an intersection design project at State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway and North College Road, starting at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, September 24, 2024.

Proposed improvements include: installing a traffic signal at the intersection; restricting the southbound US 1 left turn movement and U-turn at the intersection; realigning the driveway on the south side of the intersection and restricting the left turn movement onto southbound US 1; upgrading pedestrian sidewalks, ramps, lighting and signalization; repaving and restriping the intersection.

Construction is scheduled to start in early 2026 and last about six months. The preliminary construction cost is \$1.7 million

The meeting will consist of a formal presentation followed by an open discussion. Staff will be available to answer questions in the order they are received and as time permits. If your question is not responded to during the meeting, a response will be provided in writing afterwards.
