FDOT to Host State Road (SR) 860/Miami Gardens Drive Design Project Public Meeting

June 13, 2023

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a meeting, both in-person and virtually, for two roadway design projects along SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive from NW 27 Avenue to NE 5 Avenue, starting at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, June 13, 2023.

Proposed improvements include: closing abandoned driveways; repaving and restriping the road; improving stormwater drainage; replacing damaged sidewalks, driveways and curb and gutter; upgrading signs; improving pedestrian signalization and crosswalks; enhancing lighting; and trimming landscape. Construction is scheduled to start in early 2025 and last about 13 months. The estimated construction cost is \$9.6 million.

The meeting will consist of a formal presentation followed by an open discussion. Staff will be available to answer questions in the order they are received and as time permits. If your question is not responded to during the meeting, a response will be provided in writing afterwards.
