### **Full Closure of NW South River Drive for Emergency Railroad Crossing Repair, September 21 to September 24**

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), will close NW South River Drive from NW 28 Street to NW 31 Street beginning on Saturday, September 21 at 6 a.m. through Tuesday, September 24, at 4 a.m.

This detour is being established to allow workers to rehabilitate the railroad crossing. During this closure, all traffic will be detoured away from the crossing and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

Westbound Detour:

- Turn Left on NW 28 Street
- Turn Left on NW 37 Avenue
- Turn Right on NW 28 Street
- Turn Right on NW 42 Avenue
- Turn Right on NW 31 Street to get back to NW South River Drive

Eastbound:

- Turn Right on NW 31 Street
- Turn Left on NW 42 Avenue
- Turn Left on NW 28 Street
- Turn Left on NW 37 Avenue
- Turn Right on NW 28 Street to get back to NW South River Drive

**Please note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
