Traffic Shift at Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility (GGMTF) begins tonight

A detour will be established for drivers traveling north on State Road (SR) 9 in this area

Miami, Fla. – Beginning tonight Monday, June 1 at 9 p.m., the contractor will implement a traffic shift along SR 9 within the Green parking lot of the GGMTF. Travel lanes will be shifted while the contractor performs drainage and infrastructure work within the Green lot. Parking will remain available in the Blue and East parking lots.

A detour will be established for drivers traveling north on SR 9 in this area.

Motorists traveling north on SR 9 who wish to access the Blue parking lot will have to:

- Follow detour signs through Green lot
- Turn south on the circulation road
- Head east on Connector Road
- Turn north on the circulation road
- Turn west on the circulation road

Motorists traveling north on SR 9 who wish to access the I-95 Express Lanes will have to:

- Follow detour signs through Green lot
- Turn south on Circulation Road
- Head east on Connector Road
- Follow signs for I-95 Express Lanes
