Hialeah Gardens Boulevard Nighttime Median Reconstruction Begins May 26

From W 80 Street to W 84 Street/NW 138 Street

Miami, Fla. – Beginning Tuesday, May 26 through Thursday, May 28, 2020, between 8 p.m. and 6:30 a.m., the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close the inside travel lanes of northbound and southbound Hialeah Gardens Blvd, from NW 138 Street to W 84 Street/Graham Dairy Road, in order to perform the reconstruction of the traffic median.

Motorists will still be permitted to travel from northbound Hialeah Gardens Blvd to westbound NW 138 Street, and also southbound Hialeah Gardens Blvd to eastbound W 84 Street/Graham Dairy Road. No traffic detour will be implemented.

Drivers should anticipate delays traveling through this area and seek alternate routes if possible. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions, and please use caution when traveling through construction zones.
