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Closures on I-95, I-395, SR 836 and Adjacent Ramps

MIAMI, Fla. – The following closures on I-95, I-395, SR 836, adjacent ramps and local roads will be scheduled as noted below:

I-95 Closures

- Thursday, February 4 through Saturday, February 6 and Monday, February 8 through Saturday, February 13 - Up to four lanes on southbound I-95 from NW 29 Street to NW 8 Street will be closed nightly between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Fridays and Saturdays will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- Thursday, February 4 through Saturday, February 6 and Monday, February 8 through Saturday, February 13 - Up to four lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed nightly from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Fridays and Saturdays will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.

Continuous Weekend Lane Closures on Northbound I-95

- Friday, February 5 Through Sunday, February 7 - Up to two lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed from NW 8 Street to NW 14 Street starting at 11 p.m. on Friday until 11 a.m. on Sunday to allow the contractor to replace concrete pavement.

Southbound I-95 Ramp to Westbound SR 836 Detour

- Thursday, February 4 - The southbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95
 - Exit at SW 7 Street/Brickell Avenue (Exit 1B), then turn left at SW 8 Street
 - Enter the northbound I-95 ramp, then access the ramp to westbound SR 836

Southbound I-95 Ramp to Eastbound I-395 Detour

- Friday, February 5 and Saturday, February 6 - The southbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95, exit at the NW 8 Street (Exit 3B)
 - Turn left on NW 8 Street, continue east on NW 8 Street

- Turn left at Biscayne Boulevard to access the A1A North/Miami Beach Ramp

Northbound I-95 Ramp to Westbound SR 836 Detour

- Friday, February 5 And Saturday, February 6 - The northbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Enter the eastbound I-395 ramp
 - Exit at NE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2B), then turn right on NE 2 Avenue
 - Turn right on NE 11 Street
 - Turn right on NE 1 Avenue to access westbound I-395 to continue onto westbound SR 836

Southbound I-95 Ramp to NW 8 Street Detour

- Monday, February 8 through Saturday, February 13 - The southbound I-95 ramp to NW 8 Street will be closed as needed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95, then exit at the SW 7 Street/Brickell Avenue (Exit 1B) ramp
 - Continue to SW 8 Street, then turn left to access the northbound I-95 ramp
 - Continue north on I-95 and exit at the NW 2 Street/Arena (Exit 2B) ramp
 - Continue north on NW 3 Avenue to connect with NW 8 Street

I-395 Mainline Lane Closures

- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - One lane on mainline eastbound I-395 will be closed from I-95 to Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 – One lane on mainline westbound I-395 will be closed from I-95 to Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Westbound I-395 Ramp to Northbound I-95 Detour

- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - The westbound I-395 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closure on the evening of Miami Heat home games will begin at 11 p.m. Drivers can:
 - Access the southbound I-95 ramp
 - Exit at SW 7 Street/Brickell Avenue (Exit 1B), then turn left at SW 8 Street
 - Enter the northbound I-95 ramp, then continue north on I-95

North Bayshore Drive Ramp to Eastbound MacArthur Causeway

- Thursday, February 4 and Friday, February 5 - The North Bayshore Drive ramp lane to eastbound MacArthur Causeway will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closure on Friday will be between the hours of 11:45 p.m. and 6 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Turn right on NE 13 Street, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard

- Turn right on NE 11 Street, then turn left on NE 2 Avenue
- Turn left on NE 10 Street, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard to access the ramp to MacArthur Causeway

Roundabout Construction at NW 4 Avenue Behind the Overtown Plaza

- Starting on Monday, February 8, the contractor will begin preliminary work in the area of the roundabout located on NW 4 Avenue behind the Overtown Plaza for approximately two weeks. The work is necessary to allow truck and vehicle access to the rear of the plaza during a future phase of bridge construction when the alleyway and southernmost driveway of the plaza will need to be closed.

Southbound NE 1 Avenue Closures

- Friday, February 12 - One southbound lane on NE 1 Avenue will be closed from NE 13 Street to I-395 between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Flaggers will be onsite to guide traffic around the work zone.

Long Term Closure of NW Miami Court and NW 13 Street

- NW Miami Court and NW 13 Street will remain closed until Sunday, February 28 to allow the contractor to safely install bridge segments. Access to business driveways will be maintained.

SR 836 Lane Closures

- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - Two lanes on eastbound SR 836 from NW 17 Avenue to I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - Two westbound lanes on SR 836 from I-95 to NW 17 Avenue will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Eastbound SR 836 Ramp to Northbound I-95 Detour

- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - The eastbound SR 836 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Access the southbound I-95/NW 8 Street ramp, then exit at the NW 8 Street/PortMiami ramp
 - Turn left at NW 8 Street
 - Turn left at NW 3 Avenue to access the northbound I-95 ramp

Northbound NW 17 Avenue Ramp to Westbound SR 836 Detour

- Thursday, February 4, Friday, February 5 and Sunday, February 7 through Friday, February 12 - The northbound NW 17 Avenue ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers on NW 17 Avenue going west on SR 836 can:
 - Go west on NW 7 Street
 - Turn right on NW 27 Avenue to access the westbound SR 836 ramp

Daytime/Nighttime NW 7 Avenue Lane Closures

- Thursday, February 4 through Friday, February 12 – One southbound lane on NW 7 Avenue will remain continuously closed from NW 14 Street to NW 15 Street until 5 p.m. on Friday, February 12.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.

The work is part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
