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Closures on I-95, I-395, SR 836 and Adjacent Ramps

MIAMI, Fla. – The following closures on I-95, I-395, SR 836, adjacent ramps and local roads will be scheduled as noted below:

I-95 Closures

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21 - Up to four lanes on southbound I-95 from NW 29 Street to NW 8 Street will be closed nightly between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will be closed at 9 p.m. and additional lanes will be closed at 10 p.m. Closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.
- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21 - Up to four lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed nightly from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will be closed at 9 p.m. and additional lanes will be closed at 10 p.m. Closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m.

Southbound I-95 Ramp to Westbound SR 836 Detour

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21 - The southbound I-95 ramp to westbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95
 - Exit at SW 7 Street/Brickell Avenue (Exit 1B), then turn left at SW 8 Street
 - Enter the northbound I-95 ramp, then access the ramp to westbound SR 836

NW 8 Street Ramp to Northbound I-95 Closure

- Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21- The NW 8 Street ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed as needed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go east on NW 5 Street, then turn left at NE 1 Avenue
 - Access the westbound I-395 entrance ramp to I-95 north

Southbound I-95 Ramp to NW 8 Street Detour

- Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21- The southbound I-95 ramp to NW 8 Street will be closed as needed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95, then exit at the SW 7 Street/Brickell Avenue (Exit 1B) ramp
 - Continue to SW 8 Street, then turn left to access the northbound I-95 ramp
 - Continue north on I-95 and exit at the NW 2 Street/Arena (Exit 2B) ramp
 - Continue north on NW 3 Avenue to connect with NW 8 Street

Northbound I-95 Ramp to Eastbound I-395 Detour

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13, Sunday November 15 and Monday, November 16 - The northbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit at the NW 2 Street ramp (Exit 2B)
 - Continue north on NW 3 Avenue, then turn right on NW 8 Street
 - Continue east on NW/NE 8 Street
 - Turn left on Biscayne Boulevard to access A1A North/Miami Beach

Southbound I-95 Ramp to Eastbound I-395 Detour

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13, Sunday, November 15 and Monday, November 16 - The southbound I-95 ramp to eastbound I-395 will be closed as needed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue south on I-95, exit at the NW 8 Street (Exit 3B)
 - Turn left on NW 8 Street, continue east on NW 8 Street
 - Turn left at Biscayne Boulevard to access the A1A North/Miami Beach Ramp

Eastbound SR 112 And Westbound I-195 Ramp to Southbound I-95 Detour

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21 - The eastbound SR 112 and westbound I-195 ramps to southbound I-95 will be closed as needed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Friday and Saturday will occur between the hours of 11 p.m. and 11 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue north on I-95 and exit at NW 62 Street
 - Turn left at NW 62 Street to access the southbound I-95 ramp

I-395 Mainline Lane Closures

- Thursday, November 12, Saturday, November 14, Sunday, November 15 through Thursday, November 19 and Saturday, November 21 - One lane on mainline eastbound I-395 will be closed from I-95 to Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Saturday and Sunday will be implemented between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- Thursday, November 12, Saturday, November 14, Sunday, November 15 through Thursday, November 19 and Saturday, November 21 - One lane on mainline westbound I-395 will be closed from I-95 to Biscayne Boulevard between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Saturday and Sunday will be implemented between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m.

Closure of the Eastbound I-395 Ramp to Biscayne Boulevard

- Friday, November 13 - The eastbound I-395 ramp to Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2A) will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. for lighting maintenance. Drivers can:
 - Continue east on I-395 onto the MacArthur Causeway
 - Turn right onto Jungle Island Trail just after the Miami Children's Museum
 - Follow Jungle Island Trail and turn onto westbound MacArthur Causeway
 - Continue west on MacArthur Causeway to access the Biscayne Boulevard ramp (Exit 2)

NE 2 Avenue Closures

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13, Sunday, November 15 and Monday, November 16 - NE 2 Avenue from NE 13 Street to I-395 will be closed intermittently between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
 - Drivers on southbound NE 2 Avenue can:
 - Turn left on NE 14 Street, then turn right on Biscayne Boulevard
 - Turn right on NE 11 Street to connect with NE 2 Avenue
 - Drivers exiting I-395 can:
 - Continue east on NE 11 Terrace, then turn left on Biscayne Boulevard
 - Turn left on NE 14 Street to connect with NE 2 Avenue

Westbound I-395 Ramp to Southbound I-95 Detour

- Tuesday, November 17 - The westbound I-395 ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go north on I-95, then exit at NW 62 Street
 - Turn left at NW 62 Street to access the southbound I-95 ramp

NW 14 Street Detour

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Saturday, November 21 - NW 14 Street from NW 3 Avenue to NW 7 Avenue will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. 5:30 a.m.
 - Drivers on westbound NW 14 Street can:
 - Turn right at NW 3 Avenue, then turn left at NW 17 Street
 - Turn left at NW 7 Avenue to connect with NW 14 Street
 - Drivers on eastbound NW 14 Street can:
 - Turn left at NW 7 Avenue, then turn right at NW 17 Street
 - Turn right at NW 3 Avenue to connect with NW 14 Street

Long-Term Closure of NW 1 Place

- NW 1 Place will remain continuously closed until further notice from NW 13 Street to NW 14 Street. The long-term closure is necessary to allow the contractor to safely continue the construction of the new I-395 bridges. NW 1 Court is an alternate route.

SR 836 Lane Closures

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13 and Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - Two lanes on eastbound SR 836 from NW 17 Avenue to I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13 and Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - Two westbound lanes on SR 836 from I-95 to NW 17 Avenue will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Closures on Fridays will be implemented between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Eastbound SR 836 Ramp to Northbound I-95 Detour

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Wednesday, November 18 - The eastbound SR 836 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Go south on I-95
 - Access the NW 8 Street ramp, then exit at the NW 8 Street/PortMiami ramp
 - Turn left at NW 8 Street
 - Turn left at NW 3 Avenue to access the northbound I-95 ramp

Eastbound SR 836 Ramp to Southbound I-95 Detour

- Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - The eastbound SR 836 ramp to southbound I-95 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Access the ramp to I-95 South/NW 8 Street, then exit at NW 8 Street
 - Continue south on NW 3 Court to access the I-95 south ramp after NW 2 Street

Daytime/Nighttime Closures of NW 15 Avenue and NW South River Drive Under SR 836 For Bridge Work

- Thursday, November 12 through Saturday, November 14 and Monday, November 16 through Wednesday, November 18 - NW 15 Avenue and NW South River Drive will be closed under SR 836 as needed between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., and 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. to allow the project contractor to remove the median section of SR 836 over the roadways.

Northbound NW 12 Avenue Ramp to Eastbound SR 836 Detour

- Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - The northbound NW 12 Avenue ramp to eastbound SR 836 will be closed between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Continue north on NW 12 Avenue, then turn left on NW 12 Street
 - Turn right on NW 13 Avenue, then turn right on NW 14 Street
 - Turn right on NW 12 Avenue to access the southbound NW 12 Avenue entrance ramp to SR 836 east

NW 7 Avenue Lane Closures

- Through Saturday, November 21 - One southbound lane on NW 7 Avenue will remain continuously closed from NW 14 Street to NW 15 Street until 8 a.m. on Saturday, November 21. A second southbound lane will be closed on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. During the closure of the second lane, drivers will be diverted to the median lane until they clear the work zone.

Daytime Lane Closure of NW 17 Avenue

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13 and Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - One lane on northbound NW 17 Avenue from NW 8 Terrace to NW South River Drive will be closed between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Full Closure of NW 17 Avenue

- Thursday, November 12, Friday, November 13 and Sunday, November 15 through Friday, November 20 - NW 17 Avenue will be closed between NW 7 Street and the north side of SR 836 between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The closure on Saturday will be implemented between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - Drivers on northbound NW 17 Avenue heading west on SR 836 can:
 - Turn west on NW 7 Street
 - Turn right on NW 27 Avenue to access the SR 836 west entrance ramp
 - Drivers on northbound NW 17 Avenue continuing north can:
 - Turn west on NW 7 Street, then turn right on NW 22 Avenue
 - Turn right on NW 20 Street to connect with NW 17 Avenue
 - Drivers on southbound NW 17 Avenue continuing south can:
 - Turn west on NW 20 Street, then turn left on NW 22 Avenue
 - Turn left on NW 7 Street to connect with NW 17 Avenue

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.

The work is part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
