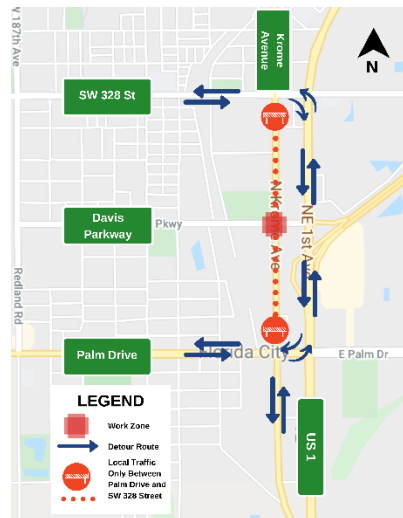

State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue and SW 336 Street/Davis Parkway Intersection Closure Begins May 6

Davis Parkway between Flagler Avenue and Krome Avenue will remain closed

Miami, Fla. – Beginning Wednesday, May 6, the intersection of Krome Avenue and Davis Parkway will be closed while the contractor rebuilds the road. The continuous closure is expected to last seven days. A detour will be established to guide drivers around the work zone through SW 328 Street and SR 9336/SW 344 Street/Palm Drive. Electronic signs will be placed near Exit 1 of Florida’s Turnpike and throughout the area to redirect traffic along SR 5/US 1/S Dixie Highway. Local traffic will be maintained along Krome Avenue between Palm Drive and SW 328 Street.



Davis Parkway between Flagler Avenue and Krome Avenue will remain closed for drainage and widening work. This closure is scheduled to last several months.
