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REVISED DATE: Lane Closure on the Westbound I-395 Ramp to Northbound I-95 Begins April 21

Miami, Fla. – On Tuesday morning, April 21, one of two lanes on the westbound I-395 ramp to northbound I-95 will be closed continuously for a period of approximately 18 months. (Wednesday morning, April 22 is the alternate date.)

The long-term ramp lane closure will allow the contractor to reconstruct portions of I-95 where the eastbound SR 836 and westbound I-395 enter I-95 as well as reconstruct the ramp. One lane will remain open during peak travel periods.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
