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Lane and Sidewalk Closures on S.R. 5/U.S. 1/Whitehead Street *Between Truman Avenue and Olivia Street in Key West*

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin sidewalk reconstruction Wednesday, October 29, on State Road (S.R.) 5/U.S. 1/Whitehead Street, in Key West, Monroe County.

This work, between Truman Avenue and Olivia Street, is expected to take approximately two weeks. Intermittent lane and sidewalk closures can be expected between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday.

Access to nearby neighborhoods and businesses will be maintained throughout the construction period.

Please use caution when traveling through construction zones and follow all posted signage. Note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
