Northbound I-95 Travel Lane Reopens Friday, October 9

Miami, Fla. – Workers have completed reconstructing a section of northbound I-95 located just north of I-395 and will reopen the outside lane between NW 14 Street and north of NW 17 Street on Friday morning, October 9.

Reconstruction of this section allows workers to continue widening the eastbound State Road (SR) 836 ramp to northbound I-95 from one lane to two lanes. Temporary barrier wall will remain in the area from NW 11 Street to north of NW 14 Street in order to separate the travel lanes from the work zone.

To reopen the lane, all northbound I-95 lanes will be closed at I-395 on Thursday, October 8 between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The northbound I-95 ramps to westbound SR 836 and eastbound I-395 will remain open during this time. Northbound I-95 drivers who want to continue north on I-95 can:

- Access the eastbound I-395 ramp, then exit at NE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard (Exit 2B)
- Turn right at NE 2 Avenue, then turn right at NE 11 Street
- Turn right at NE 1 Avenue, then access the ramp to I-95 to continue north

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
