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Northbound I-95 Lane Closures and Traffic Diversion September 30

Miami, Fla. – Exit 4A on northbound I-95, just north of I-395, will be closed tonight, Wednesday, September 30, between the hours of 8 p.m. and 11 p.m. Two northbound lanes will remain open to traffic during this time frame. At 11 p.m., Exit 4A will open and all I-95 northbound traffic will be diverted to Exit 4A to continue north on I-95. All lanes will reopen at 5:30 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
