Northbound State Road (SR) 925/NW 3 Avenue Lane Closures Begin July 20 *Between NW 3 Street and NW 5 Street*

Miami, Fla. – Beginning Monday, July 20, 2020, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will perform daily lane closures along northbound SR 925/NW 3 Avenue from NW 3 Street to NW 5 Street in order to perform drainage improvements at the intersection of SR 925/NW 3 Avenue and NW 4 Street. This work will last approximately four weeks, and will be done in the following phases to minimize the impact to the community:

- **Phase #1 (SE Corner of NW 4 Street)** – One outside travel lane and one center travel lane closure of northbound SR 925/NW 3 Avenue.
- **Phase #2 (SW Corner of NW 4 Street)** – One inside travel lane, one center travel lane closure of northbound SR 925/NW 3 Avenue and one outside travel lane closure of eastbound NW 4 Street.
- **Phase #3 (NE Corner of NW 4 Street)** – One outside travel lane and one center travel lane closure of northbound SR 925/NW 3 Avenue.
- **Phase #4 (NW Corner of NW 4 Street)** – One inside travel lane, one center travel lane closure of northbound SR 925/NW 3 Avenue and one outside travel lane closure of westbound NW 4 Street.

Please use caution when traveling through construction zones and note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
