Southbound NW 2 Avenue Lane Closed at State Road (SR) 852/NW 215 Street for Emergency Repair Work

MIAMI, Fla. – The outside southbound lane of NW 2 Avenue approaching SR 852/NW 215 Street is closed due to an unforeseen waterline break on the northwest corner of the intersection. City of Miramar crews are on site assessing the damage and the travel lane will remain closed until repairs are complete. Drivers going south on NW 2 Avenue will be able to turn right onto westbound 215 Street from the outside through lane.

Drivers should anticipate delays and seek alternate routes if possible.
