### **New Seven Mile Bridge Lane Closure Cancelled Tonight, April 21**

*Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Miami, Fla.** – The New Seven Mile Bridge will remain open to all traffic tonight, as work has been cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. Closures on Wednesday, April 22 and Thursday, April 23 will occur as scheduled at the south end of the Seven Mile Bridge between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. so the contractor can pour concrete in this area.

To perform this work safely, traffic will be maintained by flagmen while the work is being completed. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of 45 miles per hour (mph) through the construction zone.

**This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
