New Seven Mile Bridge Lane Shift Extended Through July 15

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) advises that the single lane shift that began today, July 13, on the New Seven Mile Bridge located over Moser Channel between MM 40 and MM 46.8, will now be extended through Wednesday, July 15. The shift was originally scheduled to be completed on Tuesday, July 14. The work will continue to be performed daily between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. To perform this work safely, traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
