New Seven Mile Bridge Lane Shift September 14 and Lane Closure September 16

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – On Monday, September 14, there will be a daytime single lane shift on the New Seven Mile Bridge located over Moser Channel, between MM 40 and MM 46.8, while the contractor works on the navigational lights. The work will be completed **between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.**

In addition, **on Wednesday, September 16, there will be a nighttime single lane closure between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.**, to complete striping work. To perform these activities safely, traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone, while being maintained by flagmen. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone and are encouraged to plan ahead.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
