### **New Seven Mile Bridge Lane Shift to Occur on September 8 and 9** *Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Miami, Fla.** – On Tuesday, September 8 and Wednesday, September 9, there will be a single lane shift on the New Seven Mile Bridge located over Moser Channel, between Mile MMarker (MM) 40 and MM 46.8, while the contractor continues working under the bridge.

**The work will be completed daily between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.** To perform this work safely, traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone, while being maintained by flagmen. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone.

**This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
