New Seven Mile Bridge Lane Shift to Occur on August 17 and 20

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – On Monday, August 17 and Thursday, August 20, there will be a single lane shift on the New Seven Mile Bridge located over Moser Channel, between MM 40 and MM 46.8, while the contractor performs navigational light repairs and concrete pours, respectively, on the bridge.

On Monday, the work will be completed between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. On Thursday, the work will be completed between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. To perform this work safely, traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone, while being maintained by flagmen. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
